

Cleaning Recommendations

General recommendations

To keep the fabrics in perfect condition please clean the fabrics on a regular basis. The recommendations vary depending e.g. on fabric type and coating. The usage of a steam cleaner or disinfectants can have a negative effect on the surface or damage the fabric and is therefore explicitly not recommended. Chemicals used are to be tested in unflashy areas before all-over application.

- Dry cleaning with a conventional vacuum cleaner (weekly).
- Basic cleaning (monthly, but at least every 6 months) according to the following procedure:
 1. Dry cleaning as described above.
 2. Wet cleaning with conventional wet-dry vacuum cleaner.
Spray the entire seat thoroughly. (must be wetted all-over). Vacuum the back rest from top to bottom and the seating cushion from back to the front with slight pressure. Clean the whole seat at once to prevent stains. Repeat this process immediately two times at most for resistant contamination.
 3. Depending on climate conditions, air the seat dry for at least 24 hours.

Stain cleaning

The persistence of textile finishes, effect yarns and wool can't be guaranteed once alcohol based cleaning solutions are applied. Usage of such solutions is therefore explicitly not recommended. When chemical detergents are used take care of sufficient fresh air circulation and all related safety data sheets are to be considered.
